Areas of Interest

Emphasis will be placed on supporting proactive, long term prevention and intervention programs benefiting at-risk youth, as well as providing general operating support to help sustain organizations providing services to low income and at-risk youth throughout Routt County. Grant funding will reflect the goal to support youth advocacy throughout the entire Routt County area, including North Routt, South Routt and Hayden.

Grantee Eligibility Requirements

The Craig-Scheckman Family Foundation (CSFF) makes grants to charitable tax-exempt organizations including private non-profit organizations and governmental agencies that are a part of state, county or city government that operate youth advocacy programs, community projects or educational projects that provide services to at-risk or low income youth. Youth shall be defined as newborn through eighteen years old.

The CSFF requires all public charities applying for a grant to show evidence of their 501 (c)(3) public charity status through a copy of an IRS determination letter. Government agencies must be a government run educational or public advocacy organization and must be a political subdivision of the state of Colorado. Grants to private foundations are prohibited, as are grants to individuals.

Grant Funding Cycles

There shall be two funding cycles each year. The first funding cycle deadline for grant applications will be the first business day in May with grantee notification by the first business day of June. The second funding cycle deadline will be the first business day of November with notification by the first business day of December. Most grants will fall in the category of the Standard Grant, ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000. The High

Impact Grant of \$5,001 to \$10,000 will be reserved for exceptional prevention programs/projects that will have a measurable and long-term positive impact on at-risk or low income youth. The Grant Review Committee will use discretion in selecting High Impact Grant applications and there may be funding cycles when no such grant is awarded. At the time of the written notification, grantees selected by the Grant Review Committee will also receive a contract to sign agreeing to use the grant funding for the intended purposes described in the grant application. Once the Craig-Scheckman Family Foundation receives the signed contract, the funding check will be mailed. The grant period is open ended and grants may be multi-year. Grantees are required to report on the effective use of the grant money at the completion of the project, or after one year, whatever date comes first. A reporting form shall be mailed to grantees at the time the grant check is mailed

Deadlines are the first business day of May and November. Applications for the first funding cycle will be accepted by U.S. Postal Service or may be hand delivered to the Craig-Scheckman Family Foundation office from April 1 – May 1. Applications must be postmarked by April 25 for the first May funding cycle or hand delivered by 5pm on May 1. Applications received after May 1 will not be considered.

The Craig-Scheckman Family Foundation (CSFF) was established in 2005 for charitable purposes by Sara and Michael Craig-Scheckman. The Youth Advocacy Project for Routt County (YAP) is fully funded and controlled by the CSFF and directed by Sara Craig-Scheckman. The CSFF will grant \$100,000 total in 2006, through the Youth Advocacy Project, in support of charitable tax-exempt organizations benefiting low income or atrisk youth throughout Routt County. Please note that \$20,000 will be granted during each of the May and November 2006 public funding cycles, as \$60,000 has already been granted to YAP's beneficiary agencies: Partners in Routt County, First Impressions of Routt County, and Rocky Mountain Youth Corps. After 2006, the CSFF plans to grant a total of \$150,000 annually through the Youth Advocacy Project, \$75,000 of which will be available for public funding.

Mission and Vision

The mission of YAP is to enhance the health, well being, and developmental assets in Routt County youth through the nurturing and empowerment of youth-serving agencies. The Craig-Scheckman Family Foundation's vision, through the Youth Advocacy Project, is to provide long-term local funding and hands-on developmental support to charitable youth-serving agencies throughout Routt County, in order to enhance and assist in sustaining the effective services these agencies currently provide to low income and atrisk youth.
