AGREEMENT OF MERGER

Agreement of Merger made January 6, 2006 between and among The Ronald A. and Victoria Mann Simms Foundation, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation (the "First Foundation") and The Simms/Mann Family Foundation, a Delaware corporation (the "Second Foundation"),

WHEREAS, the First Foundation is a California nonprofit public benefit corporation that has been recognized as a tax-exempt organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and has been classified as a private foundation described in Section 509(a) of the Code; and

WHEREAS, the Second Foundation is a Delaware corporation that has been recognized as a tax-exempt organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and has been classified as a private foundation described in Section 509(a) of the Code;

WHEREAS, the Boards of Directors of the First Foundation and the Board of Directors and sole member of the Second Foundation, respectively, deem it advisable and generally to the advantage and welfare of the two foundations that the First Foundation merge with and into the Second Foundation under and pursuant to the provisions of the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law of the State of California and of the General Corporation Law of the State of Delaware.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual agreements herein contained, and of the mutual benefits hereby provided, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. **Merger.** The First Foundation shall be merged with and into the Second Foundation, at the Effective Time. The Merger shall have the effects set forth in the applicable provisions of the Delaware General Corporation Law.
2. **Effective Time.** This Agreement of Merger shall become effective at February 15, 2006 (the "Effective Time"), provided that the laws of the States of Delaware and California shall have been complied with on or prior to the Effective Time.
3. **Surviving Corporation.** The Second Foundation shall survive the Merger herein contemplated, and shall continue to be governed by the laws of Delaware, but the separate corporate existence of the First Foundation shall cease forthwith at the Effective Time.
4. **Certificate of Incorporation.** The Certificate of Incorporation of the Second Foundation as it exists at the Effective Time shall be the Certificate of Incorporation of the Second Foundation following the Effective Time, unless and until the same shall be amended or repealed in accordance with the provisions thereof.
5. **Bylaws.** The Bylaws of the Second Foundation as they exist at the Effective Time shall be the Bylaws of the Second Foundation following the Effective Time, unless and until the same shall be amended or repealed in accordance with the provisions thereof.
6. **Board of Directors and Officers.** The members of the Board of Directors and the officers of the Second Foundation, immediately after the Effective Time of the Merger, shall be those persons who were the members of the Board of Directors and the officers, respectively, of the Second Foundation immediately prior to the Effective Time of the Merger, and such persons

shall serve in such offices, respectively, for the terms provided by law or in the Bylaws, or until their successors are elected and qualified.


7. **Further Assurance of Title.** If at any time the Second Foundation shall consider or be advised that any acknowledgments or assurances in law or other similar actions are necessary or desirable in order to acknowledge or confirm in and to the Second Foundation any right, title, or interest of the First Foundation held immediately prior to the Effective Time, the First Foundation and its proper officers and directors shall and will execute and deliver all such acknowledgments or assurances in law and do all things necessary or proper to acknowledge or confirm such right, title, or interest in the Second Foundation as shall be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Agreement of Merger and its proper officers and directors hereof are fully authorized to take any and all such action in the name of the First Foundation or otherwise.

8. **Rights and Liabilities of the Second Foundation.** At and after the Effective Time of the Merger, the Second Foundation shall succeed to and possess, without further act or deed, all of the rights, privileges, powers, and franchises, both public and private, and all of the property, real, personal and mixed, of each of the parties hereto; all debts, liabilities, and duties of the respective parties hereto shall attach to the Second Foundation and may be enforced against it to the same extent as if such debts, liabilities and duties had been incurred or contracted by it; and the Second Foundation shall indemnify and hold harmless the officers and directors of each of the parties hereto against all such debts, liabilities and duties and against all claims and demands arising out of the Merger.




