The accounting for this entity has been revised so that book value is equal to the capital account of the partnership as shown on Form K-1. In prior years, the Form K-1 was not always recieved on a timely basis and it was necessary to estimate the value and income from this entity. The partnership was partially redeemed due to a forced sale of one of the properties that had been leased to K-Mart which voided the lease upon its bankruptcy.
