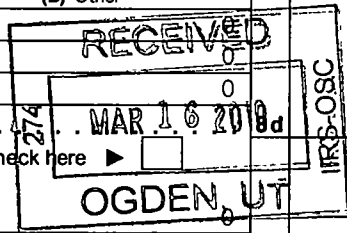

**ESCO Technologies Foundation Scholarship Program**
