Form 990, Schedule A, Part III, Question 3a. ESCO Technologies Foundation Scholarship Program

The foundation has established a scholarship program that awards scholarships each year to children of employees of ESCO Technologies Inc. Specifically, all children or stepchildren of active, full or part-time employees of the Company and its domestic subsidiaries (except for children of Corporate officers and subsidiary presidents) are eligible. The scholarship may be used for any accredited technical school or accredited two or four-year college or university. The Foundation has established a scholarship committee of individuals unaffiliated with ESCO Technologies Inc. This committee takes the annual applications and determines the award recipients each year based on the merits of their applications. During the last fiscal year the Foundation gave four scholarships of \$2500 each.
