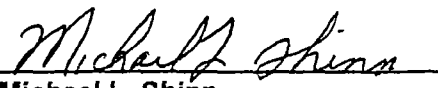

AMENDMENT OF EXISTING SECTION 4.3.3

(The new language is underlined, below.)

Section 4.3.3

The Indianapolis Animal Care and Control Administrator (the "Administrator") shall be a Director of the Board. The Administrator shall be governed by and have the same authority as any other Director, however, the Administrator is not subject to the terms set forth in Sections 4.3.2, 4.4, 4.5 or 4.6. The Administrator shall be included in the total number of Directors pursuant to Section 4.3.1. The Administrator shall have the authority to designate a single staff member of Indianapolis Animal Care and Control who may serve as a proxy for the Administrator on the Board of Directors in the Administrator's absence at no more than three Board meetings in a calendar year. The Administrator's proxy shall have the same authority granted to the Administrator in these three or fewer Board meetings.
