The John H High Family Irrevocable Scholarship Trust (Trust) submits the following information in support of its application of the provisions of IRC Sec. 4942(a) to the undistributed income of the 2006 tax year

Facts Regarding the Incorrect Valuation

The Trust filed Form 1023, Application for Recognition of Exemption Under 501 (c)(3), requesting to be classified as a public charity. The Trust filed all required tax returns on form 990 because the IRS had not responded to Form 1023. After the returns were filed, the exemption under 501(c)(3) was granted, however, the Trust was classified as a private foundation

The incorrect valuation was due to reasonable cause and was not willful. The failure to value the Trust's assets correctly was due solely to the fact that the IRS had not notified the Trust of the classification a non-operating private foundation and subsequent distribution requirements

Actions Taken to Comply with IRC Sec. 4942(a)(2)(B), (C), and (D) and the Related Regulations

The trust has resubmitted all prior tax return, reporting as a non-operating private foundation on Form 990-PF rather than a public charity on Form 990. The trust will pay all required cumulative distribution amounts for all years as soon as possible in the 2010 tax year.
