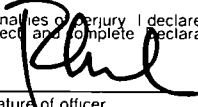

THE FORM 990 HAS ALSO BEEN AMENDED TO REFLECT THE CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN IN CONNECTION WITH A FUND HELD BY EL PASO COMMUNITY FOUNDATION (EPCF) THE LUIS JIMENEZ MEMORIAL ART SCHOLARSHIP FUND (THE FUND) WAS ORIGINALLY ESTABLISHED BY THE BURKITT FOUNDATION ON JULY 15, 2006, BEFORE THE PASSAGE OF THE PENSION PROTECTION ACT RESTRICTING DISTRIBUTIONS FROM DONOR ADVISED FUNDS THE SCHOLARSHIP DISTRIBUTIONS WERE MADE FROM THE FUND IN 2007, 2008 AND 2009 AS SOON AS EPCF DETERMINED THAT DISTRIBUTIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS FROM THE FUND WERE NO LONGER ALLOWED UNDER SECTION 4966 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE BECAUSE OF THE COMPOSITION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE, ALL SCHOLARSHIP DISTRIBUTIONS FROM THE FUND IMMEDIATELY CEASED EPCF THEN WORKED WITH THE ORIGINAL DONOR TO THE FUND, THE BURKITT FOUNDATION, TO REMEDY THE ISSUE THE BURKITT FOUNDATION AMENDED THE ORIGINAL INSTRUMENT OF TRANSFER CREATING THE FUND ON MAY 19, 2011, RENAMING THE FUND AS THE LUIS JIMENEZ FUND AND CONVERTING ITS PURPOSE FROM A SCHOLARSHIP FUND TO A GENERAL CHARITABLE PURPOSE FUND, AS EVIDENCED BY THE AMENDED INSTRUMENT OF TRANSFER, ATTACHED TO FORM 4720 AS EXHIBIT I
