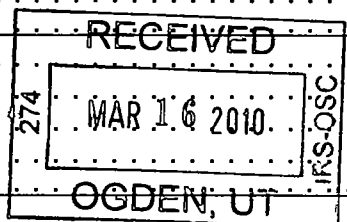

ESCO Technologies Foundation Scholarship Program

The foundation has established a scholarship program that awards scholarships each year to children of employees of ESCO Technologies Inc.
