

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

For the Year Ended December 31, 2008

A. Nature of Organization:

The Organization – The Episcopal Church at Cornell is a not-for-profit corporation, grounded in the gospel of Jesus Christ and surrounded by the life of Cornell University, and exists to raise up and support the study, fellowship, service and worship, faithful and creative Christians for ministry in the world.

B. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies:

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the cash basis of accounting, a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles. Income is recognized when cash is received. Expenses are recognized when cash is disbursed.

Investments are reported at current market value. Unrealized gains and losses on investments are included in the statement of activities.

C. Investments:

Investments consist of money funds and mutual funds maintained in brokerage accounts, and the Foundation's share of pooled investment funds maintained by Cornell University and the Episcopal Diocese of Central New York.

D. Affiliates:

The Church is affiliated with the Foundation for the Episcopal Church at Cornell University and the Episcopal Church at Cornell Student Ministry Irrevocable Charitable Trust, both of which exist to hold title to investment funds whose proceeds are used to support the operations of the Church.

E. Estimates:

Estimates and Assumptions - Management of the Organization uses estimates and assumptions in preparing financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. Those estimates and assumptions affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities, and the reported revenues and expenses. Actual results could vary from the estimates that management uses.
