Foundation Conference: The Second Annual Dysferlin Conference, held from June 14-18, 2008 in Puerto Rico, brought together leading scientists to discuss recent research and progress towards a therapy for Limb Girdle Muscular Dystrophy 2B (LGMD2B) and Miyoshi Myopathy, which are caused by mutations in the protein dysferlin. An important goal of the Dysferlin Conference is to bring together and facilitate discussion between the leaders of different fields that may contribute to the development of a therapy or cure: clinician scientists who see dysferlin patients and study their genetic mutations; researchers who study the role of the dysferlin protein and how its absence causes this disease; experts in the processes of membrane fusion and repair (in which dysferlin is now known to participate); and leaders in emerging muscle-targeted and gene-targeted therapies (including gene therapy, stem cell therapy, stop codon read-through, exon skipping, and enhanced muscle regeneration).

The Jain Foundation implemented a number of new initiatives at the conference designed to stimulate discussion and encourage collaboration around tangible, focused goals. For example: 1) The conference included two 100-minute breakout discussion sessions, during which participants were split into groups to discuss the roadblocks facing different avenues of research. The Jain Foundation team members pushed each group to reach a consensus on tangible experiments that can address these roadblocks. 2) Investigators funded by the Jain Foundation were asked to develop a flow chart outlining the path their project will ideally take towards a therapy for LGMD2B/Miyoshi, including the new materials, technologies, and basic information that they will need along the way, and to highlight their progress along that path so far. These flow charts were included in the conference booklet to encourage constructive discussion of each funded project.

Research Resources: One goal of the Jain Foundation is to promote cross-collaboration between scientists and labs along many different research lines. The foundation encourages labs to share ideas and collaborate in order to improve the quality of research results and reduce the costs and time of experiments. Two initiatives in this regard have been the establishment and maintenance of a Researcher Forum and the development of the Resources for Researchers, both of which are accessible on the foundation's website.

The Researcher forum: This is a sounding board for scientific ideas and results specific to LGMD2B with other members of the scientific community. It forms bridges between scientists and acts as a catalyst to new and creative approaches and discussions on this rare disease. Additionally, the Foundation launched the Jain Foundation Resource Sharing Network on the Foundation's website in 2008. Resources for Researchers: The Foundation reviews and summarizes research from all over the world and makes these reviews available on the website as a database of specific and pertinent information. Having complex information and scientific results synthesized in an easy to navigate manner increases efficiency of all projects. The foundation is committed to developing and providing frequently required reagents, the unavailability of which slows down research. For example, four full length dysferlin cDNAs were designed and synthesized (through a company) by the foundation and are made available to researchers free of charge, upon direct request to the Jain Foundation.

While the focus of its funded research is LGMD2B, the resulting scientific advances and collaborations will also have a broader impact on human health through their relevance to other conditions, including muscle disorders in general, degenerative diseases of tissues other than muscle, and normal aging. Examples include those on stem cell therapy, gene therapy, editing within DNA and RNA, repair of cellular injury, and interventional membrane biology. The foundation is very hands on in its approach to funding. We closely monitor progress of every project we fund (every month) and keep track of results and agreed upon timelines. Our goal is to fund all different but possible approaches to a cure.

Patient Identification and Registration: Given the relative rarity of \$ this disease, one of the goals of the Foundation is to identify a worldwide LGMD2B patient population. The Foundation has also undertaken the task of educating neuromuscular physicians about LGMD2B by participating at relevant physician meetings and by targeted mailing of information about the disease.
