During the tax year, the Foundation was the sole member of EHF Transition, LLC (the "LLC"), which was a Washington single-member limited liability company. The LLC was formed in connection with the transaction described in Statement 10 below (the "Transaction"). In connection with the Transaction, the Foundation's predecessor, Empire Health Services, sold its hospital and healthcare operations to a for-profit acquirer. The Transaction included the assets of Empire Health Services and, as well, the assets and operations of its various subsidiary entities. The shells of the subsidiaries continued to exist, however. The Foundation formed the LLC for the limited purpose of taking title to the stock, membership or partnership interests in the now-defunct subsidiaries as of the closing of the Transaction. Following the closing of the Transaction on October 1, 2008, the LLC proceeded to arrange for the subsidiaries to be dissolved or terminated under state law. Except as provided below, none of the subsidiaries had any operations, revenues or expenses, or assets at any point in time after they became subsidiaries of the LLC in connection with the closing of the Transaction. The sole exception to this involves one subsidiary entity that, although ceasing its operations as of the closing of the Transaction, continued to be obligated under an outstanding lease arrangement. That entity, as well as the LLC, will be dissolved or terminated as soon as the outstanding arrangement expires.
