#### Harding Heritage Foundation Reason for Amending Return 12/31/2008

By way of background, Harding Heritage Foundation was originally structured as a public charity. During preparation of the 2008 return, it was determined that the Foundation no longer qualified as a public charity and reclassified the organization to a private foundation. Therefore, a Form 990-PF was prepared using the existing books and records. As such, the return was prepared with the best information available at the time.

It was later discovered that the books and records used in preparing the return, were not sufficient to accurately prepare the 990-PF as most items were stated at cost and fair market value information had not been prepared. In addition, some accounting errors were made.

Since that time, the information was gathered and the accounting information was reconstructed so that the 2008 return could be more accurately prepared. This was done to ensure that carryover items that flow to subsequent would also be accurately reflected.
