Description

The purpose of this organization shall be to promote, through financial support, voluntary Senior Companion Programs. Eligibility for financial support are Senior Companion Programs established to provide low-income older adults with the opportunity to serve their communities in retirement years in charitable endeavors and educational programs not for pecuniary gain. The Foundation shall promote and support Senior Companion Programs to work in a variety of settings including, but not limited to, volunteering to work in mental health facilities with the mentally ill and developmentally disabled older adults. Companions assist chronically-impaired older adults including veterans, alzheimer patients, those who are blind and deaf, recovering substance abusers, men and women recuperating from major surgery, as well as those who are simply frail after long lives. Respite care is also one of the many contributions a Senior Companion makes.
