





TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Iowa Nonprofit Corporation Act, Chapter 504A of the 1995 Code of Iowa, as amended, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

1. Name. The name of the Corporation is A & I Foundation.
2. Duration. The period of its duration is perpetual.
3. Purposes. The purposes of the corporation shall be:
 - 3.1 To operate exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes in accordance with the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
 - 3.2 To pay principal and income to any corporation, or trust, or community chest, fund or foundation or other appropriate entity, organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes in accordance with the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
 - 3.3 To solicit and receive contributions, gifts, grants, devises or bequests of real or personal property or both from individuals, foundations, partnerships, associations, governmental bodies or public or private corporations, and to maintain, use and apply the principal or the income therefrom, subject to the limitations in these Articles of Incorporation.
4. Powers. This corporation shall have and exercise all powers given nonprofit corporations under the Iowa Nonprofit Corporation Act and shall be authorized to do any lawful act in furtherance of any and all lawful purposes for which corporations may be organized under such Act.
5. Restrictions. No part of the property or earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, trustee, officer, shareholder or individual other than as reasonable compensation for services rendered. The corporation shall not carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence

legislation nor shall it participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

6. Dissolution. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or to such organization or organizations organized or operated exclusively for the charitable purposes as shall at the time qualify as exempt under Sections 501 (c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (and are other than private foundations under Section 509 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986), in such manner as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the district court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations described in this Article as the Court shall determine.

7. Indemnity. This corporation shall indemnify any present or former director, officer, employee, member or volunteer of this corporation, and each such person who is servicing or who has served, at the request of this corporation, as a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, other enterprise or employee benefit plan to the fullest extent possible against expenses, including attorney's fees, judgments, fines, settlements and reasonable expenses, actually incurred by such person relating to his or her conduct as director, officer, employee, member or volunteer of this corporation or as a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, other enterprise or employee benefit plan, except that the mandatory indemnification required by this sentence shall not apply (i) to a breach of the duty of loyalty to the corporation, (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or knowing violation of the law, or (iii) for a transaction from which such person derived improper personal benefit.
