MEMO REGARDING: FILING FORM 990 FOR YEARS 2006 through 2010

Living Faith Ministeries, Inc. (taxpayer) filed its original Form 990 as part of a consolidated return with its parent, Living Faith Broadcasting, Inc., FEIN 20-1680481.

Living Faith Ministeries, Inc. received letters from the IRS stating that it had not filed its Form 990.

After much correspondence with the IRS regarding this matter, in February 2012 the IRS notified Living Faith Broadcasting, Inc. that it would be required to file amended returns from 2006 through 2010 and that Living Faith Ministeries, Inc. would have to file separate returns for each of those years.

Consolidated returns were originally filed because of the Parent-Subsidiary relationship of the two entities. However, the IRS determined that the two entities had not filed a group application for exemption, but had filed separate Form 1023's. Each entity was granted its individual exemption which precludes them from filing a consolidated tax return.

Therefore, Living Faith Broadcasting, Inc. is filing amended returns and Living Faith Ministeries, Inc. is filing separate returns for all of the years (2006-2010) involved in this matter.

The entire group of returns is being filed at the same time, in the same package, so that they can be processed together according to instructions via telephone from Mrs. Cavanaugh of the IRS.
