**The primary program service that is undertaken by MANNA Worldwide is the operation of feeding centers and orphanages for indigent children around the world. The organization currently operates 95 feeding centers, which provide nutritious meals and educational opportunities for its participants on a daily basis. In addition to these centers, there are also 15 orphanages which are located in 37 different countries around the world. Finally, there are also seven backpack programs in the United States which provide assistance to students involved in the reduced school lunch programs. Overall, MANNA Worldwide feeding programs are used by over 7000 children each day.**

**Another program service offered by MANNA Worldwide is the opportunity to travel to various locations and observe firsthand the impact of the programs sponsored by the organization. In 2008, over 700 people were involved with 46 different trips conducted in more than 20 countries. These participants were able to view the tremendous difference in the lives of the children as a result of the MANNA program services.**

**MANNA Worldwide has eight directors, who are self-supported, that travel to over 100 churches throughout the year to present the mission of the organization. The primary purpose of this travel is to promote MANNA Worldwide by reporting the results and success of the feeding center operations of MANNA, and to host MANNA Sundays where special offerings are received and new donors are encouraged to become involved and past contributors are encouraged to increase their level of participation.**
