Publications include "A Way Forward" The publication was formally submitted to the Joint Task Force on Basic Education Finance and over 10,000 copies were distributed to date. The Foundation also released "Pay-for-Performance Models" and the "Ready for Life? Action Kit." The "2009 Citizens' Report Card on Washington State Education" was produced. The latter publication was released in January, 2009 and 25,000 copies were distributed.

Grants - Program Expenses 100,198

Continued to work with K-12 finance experts statewide and national expert John Tapogna to produce "A Way Forward", a proposal submitted to the Basic Education Finance Task Force. This proposal was one of five under consideration during the final weeks of the task force.

Outreach to stakeholder and community groups to build the Foundation into a credible, non-partisan source of information on educational issues in Washington State. This included the creation of the Excellent Schools Now Coalition, co-chaired by LEV Foundation, a broad-based group of organizations working together to improve the public education outcomes for all kids Outreach also included the development and release of the Ready for Life? public education campaign.

Grants - Program Expenses 281,280

LEV Foundation conducted comprehensive public opinion research (including five focus groups and one statewide poll) to test public awareness and support for education issues and specific messages, including readiness for education reform

Grants - Program Expenses 194,203

Support of direct and grassroots lobbying efforts to improve public education in Washington State. The efforts were successful in two key areas. First was the increase of funding by the State Legislature in 2008. The second was the State Board of Education's adoption of CORE 24, which urged the legislature to increase high school graduation requirements from 19 credits to 24 credits including a 3rd year of math.
