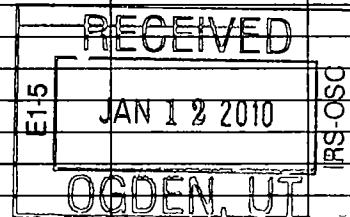

### How do I know if my organization is eligible to receive a grant from Best Buy Children's Foundation?

To request a charitable contribution, your organization must be a federally tax-exempt, section 501(c)(3) charitable organization. Best Buy Children's Foundation provides grants to organizations that use interactive technology in creative ways to engage students and get them excited about learning.

### My 501(c)(3) has a pending status; do I qualify to receive a donation?

No. Best Buy and Best Buy Children's Foundation do not fund organizations with a pending 501(c)(3) status. Only organizations that are verified with a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) designation, as determined by the Internal Revenue Service, are eligible to receive donations.

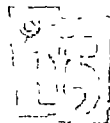
