# United Way of Harrisonburg and Rockingham County

### FY 2008-09 Tax Return/990

The mission of the United Way of Harrisonburg and Rockingham County is to improve lives by mobilizing the community to create lasting changes in conditions. Our vision is to be a premier community building organization. We accomplish this by partnering with individuals, businesses, government and other non-profit organizations to address the greatest needs of the most vulnerable persons in our community. Our strategy is to:

- Identify and assess areas of critical human need
- Set priorities and focus on four priority areas
- Mobilize resources and support solutions
- Measure results and create impact.

Accomplishments in the Fiscal Year Ending April 30, 2009 include:

- Generating \$1,102,154 to invest in the *Community Impact Fund* for programs addressing the most vulnerable persons in our community, including persons with low-incomes, disabilities, language barriers, and persons in crisis. This was the largest amount raised in an annual campaign in the 52 history of the organization.
- Investing these resources into four Community Impact Areas, each one
  managed by a team of local agency directors and expert community volunteers.
  The four impact areas include: Ready Children; Successful Youth; Self Sufficient
  Families; Independent Adults. A total of 31 community partner agencies are
  receiving grants that support 37 different health and human service programs.
- Measuring the outcomes of *United Way investments* in each program with results such as:
  - 205 families received child care scholarships to enable them to afford quality childcare at one of the three United Way child care centers.
  - 436 health care visits provided to low income, uninsured, working adults
  - 77 nights of safe shelter provided to homeless individuals
  - 3100 hot, nutritious meals delivered to frail, home bound older adults
- 4. Partnering with James Madison University, the Shenandoah Valley Small Business Development Center and the Harrisonburg Rockingham Chamber of Commerce to provide the third *Non-Profit Institute* (NPI). NPI is a professional development certificate program designed to equip today's non-profit manager with practical skills for effective leadership. 27 local non-profit leaders graduated from the program.

- 5. Partnering with <u>Wal-Mart Distribution Center</u> and Mercy House Shelter to complete an *Extreme Home Makeover* for the Sandel House. This shelter provides care to pregnant and parenting teen girls who have no other means of safe and secure shelter. Opening of the facility was made possible through the in-kind gifts of labor and goods provided by <u>Wal-Mart and</u> its employees.
- 6. Partnering with the *Smart Beginnings Shenandoah Valley* (formally Success By 6 Coalition of the Shenandoah Valley) to promote early childhood development and school readiness in our region. The coalition received a grant of \$400,000 from the Virginia Early Childhood Foundation which will be completed in June 2009. Services implemented through this grant include: Success By 6 Academy for Families; Success By 6 Academy for Child Care Providers; a public awareness campaign; and Transition to Kindergarten program. United Way of Harrisonburg and Rockingham County serves as fiscal agent and co-chair of the coalition. An Early Childhood Leadership Summit was held for the fourth year in January 2009, involving 150 community leaders setting goals and strategies for the organization.
- 7. Partnering with Q101 Verstandig Radio, Wal-Mart, Harrisonburg City and Rockingham County Schools to hold the second *Stuff the Bus* event in the community. The effort resulted in collecting over 1,496 bags of donated school supplies valued at \$14,000, over twice the amount of donations raised in 2007. These school supplies were delivered to the public schools to be given to children who were unable to purchase their own supplies.
- 8. Serving as the local *Emergency Food and Shelter Board* coordinating body for Harrisonburg and Rockingham County. The Board is convened by United Way and in calendar year 2008 \$23,697 was awarded to Salvation Army for disbursement in the community. All disbursements are for the purpose of rent and mortgage assistance.
