This past year, the committee hosted the FedEx Orange Bowl Game, the FedEx BCS National Championship Game and affiliated Festival events attracting tens of thousands of visitors who fuel the local economy with millions of dollars. This translates into jobs and benefits for local hospitality and service industries and vendors, in line with our mission. It is estimated our 2008-09 bowl games and Festival events generated nearly \$200 million in economic impact and media added value for South Florida. The Committee continues to work to ensure that South Florida remains in the position of being one of just four communities nationwide with a spot in college football's prestigious Bowl Championship Series and a part of the National Championship rotation.

The Committee financially supports local youth sports leagues, generating competition and funding an array of grants, donations and community programs to support this competition. In this fiscal year the Committee provided funding and hundreds of volunteer and staff hours to serve more than 16,000 young football players and cheerleaders who participate in the Orange Bowl Youth Football Alliance.

The OBC championed the renovation of Moore Park, an existing city park located in one of the City of Miami's most underprivileged areas. The Committee entered into an agreement with the City of Miami to build a football stadium structure surrounded by a track, along with other improvements at Moore Park to be used for high school and youth sports competition, as well as the community at large.
