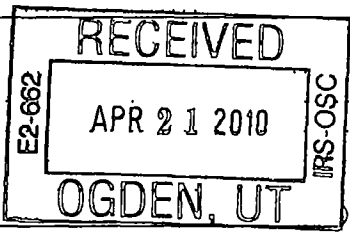

The organization was formed to foster fair trade exchanges between Mayan artisans in Guatemala, and consumers in developed countries, in efforts to combat extreme poverty in Mayan communities. To facilitate access to Mayan artisans to Fair Trade Markets, such as but not limited to fair trade retail establishments, community group promotions, and fair trade focused events in New York as well as in the United States. To organize and facilitate experiential tours from the United States to visit different artisan groups, to gain a "hands-on" understanding of Mayan, culture and to further encourage American consumers to engage in fair trade transactions. As well as to offer the opportunity to Mayan producers/artisans to visit the United States so that they can have a better understanding of the nature of domestic markets here. To identify and secure both human and financial resources to assist Mayan artisans to achieve self-sustaining communities, by improving the conditions for their general health and welfare through business engagements in fair trade markets. To support the creation and development of informational programs to enable/empower Mayan people to bring themselves out of poverty while retaining their cultural heritage in general, and specifically in the creation of production of artisan products. To engage in informational exchanges in the United States, such as but not limited to, organizing fair trade events, talks regarding the works of Mayan artisans, and sales of artisan products to build awareness and understanding among American consumers, social/community leaders, and the business community about the impacts of fair trade exchanges on the lives of Mayan artisans and, in general in the lives of community based producers in the developing world.
