Under the requirements of FIN 48, taxexempt organizations could now be required to record an obligation as the result of a tax position they have historically taken on various tax exposure items. Prior to FIN 48, the determination of when to record a liability for a tax exposure was based on whether a liability was considered probable and reasonably estimable in accordance with FASB Statement No 5, Accounting for Contingencies. On June 1, 2007, the University adopted FIN 48. There was no impact on the financial statements as of May 31, 2009 and 2008, from the adoption of FIN 48.
