#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

**Corporations Section** 

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 4.03 of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

#### ARTICLE I: Name

The name of the corporation is TEXAS BAR FOUNDATION.

#### ARTICLE V: Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 504 Lavaca Street, Suite 1005, Austin, Texas, and the name of the registered agent at such address is Andrea Stone.

#### ARTICLE VI: Board of Trustees .

The corporation shall be governed by a board of trustees comprised of sixteen members, one ex-officio with full voting rights, twelve elected by the board of directors of the State Bar of Texas, and three officers elected by the Fellows of the Texas Bar Foundation. The Fellows shall, at the annual meeting of the Fellows, elect three officers: the Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary of the Fellows. The most immediate past chair of the board of trustees, who is willing and able to serve, shall be the ex-officio member. The other twelve shall be persons chosen by the board of directors of the State Bar of Texas, with four to be elected each year, one per year to be a public member and three to be attorneys; one such attorney shall have been a member of the board of directors during the year immediately preceding the commencement of their term of office as trustee of the Texas Bar Foundation.

No person, other than those serving as public members, shall serve as trustee unless he or she is a Fellow of the Texas Bar Foundation. A trustee shall serve until his or her successor has been chosen and qualified.

Term of Office: The regular term of office of electees of the board of directors of the State Bar of Texas shall be three years in length, commencing at the beginning of the State Bar year next following their election and ending with termination of the State Bar year the third anniversary thereafter. The term of office of the Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary of the Fellows is for the year in which they hold their respective offices.

Trustee Vacancy: The board of trustees shall be the judge of the qualifications of each of its members. Notwithstanding the other terms or provisions of Article VI, in the event a member of the board of trustees resigns from service or, in the judgment of the board of trustees, is or becomes unable or unqualified to serve, or is absent from three consecutive regular quarterly meetings of the trustees without, in the judgment of the board of trustees, good cause, the board of trustees shall declare his or her position as trustee vacant. In such event, if the position declared vacant be that of an electee of the State Bar board of directors, said board of directors shall appoint another person to fill the unexpired portion of the vacated term. If the vacancy be of the immediate past chair of the board of trustees, his

or her term shall be completed by the next immediate past chair of the board of trustees able and willing to serve. If the vacancy be of the Chair, Vice-Chair, or Secretary of the Fellows, his or her term shall be completed by the immediate past chair of the Fellows able and willing to serve.

Liaison Member: In addition to providing for the election of trustees for the Texas Bar Foundation, the board of directors of the State Bar shall designate, in a manner and for such terms as may be determined by such directors, two of its members, who shall be Fellows of the Texas Bar Foundation, to serve in a liaison capacity from the State Bar to the board of trustees. In addition to having the right and duty to attend meetings of the board of trustees such persons so designated shall have all of the privileges of a trustee except the right to vote with respect to the affairs of the Foundation, and their expenses in serving in such capacity shall be borne by the Foundation in a like manner as those of the trustees.

Indemnification of Board of Trustees: The corporation shall indemnify its board of trustees under the provisions of Article 1396-2.22A of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act or any similar successor statute.

#### **ARTICLE VIII: Amendments to Articles of Incorporation**

The Articles may be amended by an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Trustees.

#### **ARTICLE IX: Original Incorporators**

The names of the original incorporators and their respective addresses at the time of original incorporation are listed here and mention is made of them in order that their place in the history of the Foundation be preserved for posterity.

#### **ARTICLE X: Dissolution**

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, either voluntary or involuntary, the net assets, if any, shall be distributed as determined by the corporation, but only to one or more educational or charitable organizations or governments or governmental agencies to which gifts and devises are deductible for all gift, estate, inheritance and income taxes, if any, imposed by the state or federal government.

#### **ARTICLE XI: Fellows Organization**

The corporation shall have no members as such. However, the support and cooperation of the public and the members of the State Bar of Texas are sought and expected. The value of the organization known as "The Fellows of the Texas Bar Foundation" in attaining these objectives is recognized, and that organization shall have the support and cooperation of the Foundation provided such minimum conditions as the trustees may prescribe in the Foundation Bylaws be met. Further, the board of trustees is authorized to adopt such Bylaws from time to time as it thinks appropriate to encourage such

support and cooperation and to give appropriate recognition to contributors and to those rendering uncommonly meritorious service to the furtherance of justice, the State Bar of Texas or this Foundation.

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TEXAS BAR FOUNDATION

#### **ARTICLE I: Name**

The name of the corporation is TEXAS BAR FOUNDATION.

#### **ARTICLE II: Status**

The corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

#### **ARTICLE III: Duration**

The period of its duration is perpetual.

#### **ARTICLE IV: Purpose**

This corporation is organized to promote the ends of justice through educational and charitable activities by sponsorship and encouragement of legal research, publications, forums and the establishment of scholarships, by fostering the institution and maintenance of legal aid facilities for the indigent, and by providing a responsible entity to receive, administer and make proper application of donations, grants and other forms of aid, from both governmental and private sources, to be used in furtherance of the foregoing purposes. Activities of the corporation or use of funds hereof for investigation or prosecution of any individual grievance matter or for the purpose of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation is expressly prohibited, but legal research, publications and forums dealing with issues of widespread interest to the public or to the Bar and affecting the ends of justice, as distinguished from specific items of legislation pending in any legislative body or committee hereof, are not within this prohibition.

In such event, if the position declared vacant be that of an electee of the State Bar board of directors, said board of directors shall appoint another person to fill the unexpired portion of the vacated term. If the vacancy be of the immediate past chair of the board of trustees, his or her term shall be completed by the next immediate past chair of the board of trustees able and willing to serve. If the vacancy be of the Chair, Vice-Chair, or Secretary of the Fellows, his or her term shall be completed by the immediate past chair of the Fellows able and willing to serve.

Liaison Member: In addition to providing for the election of trustees for the Texas Bar Foundation, the board of directors of the State Bar shall designate, in a manner and for such terms as may be determined by such directors, two of its members, who shall be Fellows of the Texas Bar Foundation, to serve in a liaison capacity from the State Bar to the board of trustees. In addition to having the right and duty to attend meetings of the board of trustees such persons so designated shall have all of the privileges of a trustee except the right to vote with respect to the affairs of the Foundation, and their expenses in serving in such capacity shall be borne by the Foundation in a like manner as those of the trustees.

Indemnification of Board of Trustees: The corporation shall indemnify its board of trustees under the provisions of Article 1396-2.22A of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act or any similar successor statute.

#### **ARTICLE VII: Administration**

The chair of the board of trustees shall preside at all meetings of the trustees and shall be the chief executive officer for the Texas Bar Foundation. In his or her absence or inability to serve, the vice-chair of the trustees shall fulfill such responsibilities. The affairs of the corporation shall be conducted by the board of trustees, the chair of the board of trustees and such committees as the board of trustees may from time to time appoint or authorize to be appointed. Such affairs shall be conducted in accordance with such Bylaws as may be approved by the board of trustees from time to time. Any matter in anywise relating to the affairs of the corporation shall be subject to regulation through such Bylaws and resolutions, so long as there is no conflict between same and these Articles of Incorporation or amendments to these Articles.

ARTICLE VIII: Amendments to Articles of Incorporation

The Articles may be amended by an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IX: Original Incorporators

#### **ARTICLE X: Dissolution**

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, either voluntary or involuntary, the net assets, if any, shall be distributed as determined by the corporation, but only to one or more educational or charitable organizations or governments or governmental agencies to which gifts and devises are deductible for all gift, estate, inheritance and income taxes, if any, imposed by the state or federal government.

#### ARTICLE XI: Fellows Organization

The corporation shall have no members as such. However, the support and cooperation of the public and the members of the State Bar of Texas are sought and expected. The value of the organization known as "The Fellows of the Texas Bar Foundation" in attaining these objectives is recognized, and that organization shall have the support and cooperation of the Foundation provided such minimum conditions as the trustees may prescribe in the Foundation Bylaws be met. Further, the board of trustees is authorized to adopt such Bylaws from time to time as it thinks appropriate to encourage such support and cooperation and to give appropriate recognition to contributors and to those rendering uncommonly meritorious service to the furtherance of justice, the State Bar of Texas or this Foundation.
