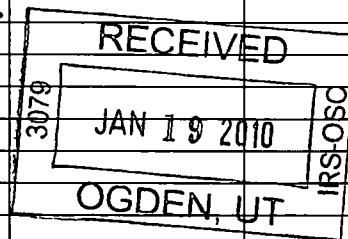

8. The first half of the scholarship will be made payable to the student and/or the institution upon verification of enrollment. Upon completion of the first semester, a statement will be required from the institution certifying that the applicant is considered by the registrar to be a regular student in good standing with a grade point level of at least 2.5 on a scale of 4.0. Upon receipt of this statement and proof of enrollment for the second semester, the additional one-half (1/2) of the scholarship will be issued.
