In 2008 Clarina Howard Nichols Center has:

- Served 558 women, children and men;
- Provided 1058 shelter nights for women and children;
- Answered over 1250 hotline calls;
- Provided emergency financial assistance to 121 survivors
- Provided 1238 contacts for criminal and family court advocacy;
- Educated over 500 children, youth and adults on issues related to sexual and domestic violence in over 100 classrooms, workshops and educational settings.

Clarina has six full time employees, one part time staff member, one AmeriCorps Member and over 3000 volunteer hours have been logged in the past year by a cadre of 40 volunteers. Clarina is the only program that specifically serves victims and survivors of domestic and sexual violence or that provides substantive outreach and education on this issue in Lamoille County. Clarina is one of 15 programs that address these concerns across the state.
