	The Board of Trustees of the College revised both the College and NEEI By-laws in fiscal 2009 with the goal to improve the functioning of both Boards while at the same time to better reflect best practices. Key changes are Maintain the College and New England Eye Institute, Inc (NEEI), its clinical teaching affiliate as two separate corporations. Have one common board where the Trustees of the College are the Directors of NEEI Ex-officio positions for the Faculty Representative, the Student Representative and the Alumni Representative continued through June 30, 2009 and ended at that time. The line of communication with these groups has been transferred to the Academic Affairs Committee with a broader charter, the new Student Affairs Committee and the Development and Alumni Affairs Committee with its expanded charters. Under the revised By-laws, faculty, students and alumni are now designated as members of these committees. The Audit and Compliance Committee is now a standing committee. A Clinical System Committee has been formed as a standing committee to provide oversight for NEEI patient care activities and related compliance issues. A prohibition on employees of the College and NEEI from serving on the Board of Trustees. Employees now serving as Trustee will be allowed to finish their current elected term. Significantly strengthened the conflict of interest section. The By-laws do not have term limits per se, but the revised version creates a duty upon the Governance and Trusteeship Committee to evaluate performance of trustees. E-mail may be used for a variety of Board and Committee purposes. The Treasurer will no longer be required to be a Board member. This will place the record-retention and record-keeping responsibilities with a full-time employee of the College. The detailed job description for the President has been replaced with a broader and briefer description of the President as chief executive officer. The new By-laws provide that the Chair will be represented to fille positions on the committee
