Additionally, the Board of Directors has adopted within the bylaws of Bridges certain policies and procedures specific to the Board regarding conflict of interest. Each Board member is required to annually sign a statement which affirms that he or she has received a copy of the conflict of interest policy, has read and understands the policy, has agreed to comply with the policy, and understands the organization is charitable and in order to maintain its federal tax exemption it must engage primarily in activities which accomplish one or more of its tax exempt purposes.
