Some trustees of Webb Institute are alumni of the college. As naval architects and marine engineers, alumni trustees often own or belong to firms doing business in the marine industry. The firms alumni trustees belong to range in size from small partnerships and LLCs all the way up to corporations. Given the small size of Webb's graduating classes (less than 20 persons per year) and given the small Webb Institute alumni base (less than 1,000 persons) as well as the highly specialized nature of the marine industry, it is not unusual for some alumni serving as trustees to have forged on occasion, a business relationship with each other. However, never has there been a direct or indirect business relationship existing between the Board of Trustees and the Institute itself.

Form 990, Part VI, Section A, Line 10:

After a review of the Form 990 return by Webb's auditors, the 2008 Form 990 return with all supporting schedules were sent by email to the members of the Audit Committee and Executive Committee for a final review and approval before filing. Webb Institute was granted two extension requests to file its 2008 Form 990 by May 15th (effectively May 17, 2010). Due to the timing of Webb's bi-annual Board of Trustee meetings that take place during the third or fourth weeks in May and October each year, the 2008 Form 990 return can only be presented to the full Board of Trustees at their next meeting date of May 21, 2010. As such, the board will rely upon its auditors, Audit and Executive Committees to sanction the return's filing on or before the 5/17/2010 deadline. It is management's intent to present future Form 990 Returns to the entire Board of Trustees for approval before filing with the IRS.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c:

The Board of Trustees is required annually at the May meeting, to sign and renew a Conflict of Interest Policy Statement. Any conflict of interest that may arise during a trustee's term requires immediate and full disclosure. Depending on circumstances, any trustee that has a conflict of interest surrounding a specific issue must recuse themselves from all decision-making processes with respect to the issue under review.
