The program seeks to educate survivors in managing their long-term health care needs, health insurance, education, and employment and psychosocial issues. The program also prepares survivors as advocates to increase local and national awareness and action around the unique issues and challenges faced by this growing community

Survivors' Lobby Day:

The annual Survivors' Lobby Day brings together young adult cancer survivors for a day of mobilizing against childhood cancer. The Children's Cause for Cancer Advocacy (CCCA) is in partnership with the American Psychological Association which offers a training workshop for the lobby day which familiarizes survivors with the federal legislative and appropriations process and instructs attendees on effective messaging strategies for visits with Congressional Members and staff.

Rise to The Challenge is an advocacy session that aims to empower young adult survivors to make a difference by telling their story to people in power. CCCA adapted this "advocacy bootcamp" to fit a variety of formats and audiences, and is taking it on the road!

In 2009, CCCA's advocacy roadshow traveled to Camp Mak-a-Dream in Montana and will be continuing on to a survivorship conference in Dallas and an advocacy program for brain tumor survivors in New York City.
