Students submit applications that include a 10-page proposal on their dissertation research, a 2-page CV and 2 letters of recommendation from faculty that they work with (one letter must be from the student's adviser). The registrar also provides the Provost's Office with copies of the students' transcripts. The Provost's Office usually receives about 200 applications per year (224 this year). The Provost's Office compiles the application packet (including the reference letters and transcripts) and organizes interdisciplinary panels by academic cluster (Social Sciences, Humanities, Sciences/Math). There are usually about 10 panels, of approximately 20 proposals each. The Executive Officers are asked to recommend faculty members to serve as reviewers and the application packets are sent to those reviewers. Usually each panel is composed of proposals from 3 different disciplines, with a faculty member from each of the represented disciplines. After reviewing the proposals on their own, the panel members meet at the GC to discuss and rank the proposals. The panels are asked to rank the top 5-7 proposals out of their group of approximately 20 applications. After all the panels have met, the Provost and Associate Provost make the final decisions on awards. The highest ranked applicant on each panel receives a major dissertation fellowship, and depending on the number of fellowships available, additional awards are given, based on the highest ranked proposal that meets the specific topics or themes and these awards are, similarly, made based on the highest ranked proposal that meets the specific award criteria. Several of the dissertation fellowships are reviewed outside of the provost's office by specific centers and institutes (i.e., the Leon Levy Center for Biography, the Ralph Bunche Institute, the european union studies Center, etc.).
