Crisis Shelter

The Crisis Center located at 609 F Street in downtown Anchorage is a 40 bed facility which provides shelter, food, clothing, counseling, family mediation and medical attention to young people ages 13 through 20. Open 24 hours a day, seven days a week; it is a safe place for at risk and homeless youth to stay.

<u>Rights of Passage</u>

Rights of Passage is a 14 bed transitional-living program for homeless youth ages 18 through 20. Residents can stay up to 12 months, with an additional 6 months of aftercare, while they learn vocational and independent living skills. The participation of the volunteer mentor is a key feature of the program. Mentors play a critical role in the development of residents who in the past have lacked effective adult influences in their lives.

Passage House

Passage House can provide residential support and services for up to 10 young mothers ages 16 through 20 and their babies. Residents can stay up to 18 months while they learn vocational and independent living skills, as well as how to raise healthy children. Our goal is to provide for the basic needs of residents and their children so they can grow and develop emotionally, intellectually and spiritually. We also promote and reinforce the values of responsible living and responsible parenting.

Community Service Center

Youth Resource Center

The Youth Resource Center located at 750 West 5th Avenue offers walk-in services and outreach to young people in need of support. Services include counseling and referral, family advocacy, family mediation services, use of telephone, sack lunches, hot/cold drinks, and mail and phone services.

<u>Outreach</u>

The street outreach program provides services to the most vulnerable youth in Anchorage, those who are living or spending a great deal of time on the streets. Our goal is to provide a link to safer activities and to help youth move toward positive change.

Job Development

The Job Development Program located at 750 West 5th Avenue assists youth with job searching, resume writing, and other employment support, tutoring, GED testing and educational support.
