NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. NATURE OF OPERATIONS AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

NATURE OF OPERATIONS

St. Joseph's Center Auxiliary (the "Auxiliary") was founded by certain officers of the Congregation of Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Scranton, Pennsylvania (the "Congregation"). The Auxiliary was formed to solicit, collect, hold or distribute property, real or otherwise, for the benefit of St. Joseph's Center (the "Center"), a not-for-profit institution, also founded by the Congregation.

The Auxiliary evaluated subsequent events for recognition or disclosure through December 7, 2009, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

USE OF ESTIMATES

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS

Cash and cash equivalents include highly liquid instruments purchased with an original maturity of three months or less.

PREPAID EXPENSES

Costs incurred for fund-raising events in advance of the event are recorded as prepaid expenses.

DEFERRED REVENUE

Revenue received for fund-raising events in advance of the event are recorded as deferred revenue.

The Auxiliary adopted Statement of Financial Accounting Standards No. 165, "Subsequent Events" ("SFAS 165") as of June 30, 2009. SFAS 165 established general standards of accounting for and disclosure of events that occur after the balance sheet date but before financial statements are issued or are available to be issued. The adoption of SFAS 165 did not have a material effect on the Auxiliary's financial statements.

2. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Auxiliary contributes funds to the Center to aid in meeting operating needs and capital expenditures of the Center. Contributions to the Center were \$542,349 in 2009 and \$670,000 in 2008.

Amounts due to the Center, for expenses paid on behalf of the Auxiliary, were \$2,575 and \$3,108 at June 30, 2009 and 2008, respectively.

3. FUNCTIONAL EXPENSES

The Auxiliary conducts fundraising activities for the benefit of the Center. Expenses related to providing these services are as follows:

4. CONCENTRATION OF CREDIT RISK

The Auxiliary maintains substantially all of its cash accounts with one financial institution. The Company periodically has amounts on deposit in excess of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation insured limits.

5. SIGNIFICANT CONCENTRATION

Approximately 85% of the Auxiliary's support and revenues was generated by the Annual Fair. The loss of this support and revenues would have an adverse impact on the Auxiliary's financial statements.
