## Exempt Purpose, Line 1, Organization's Mission

The Corporation is a nationwide nonprofit membership organization dedicated to promoting public policies that promote economic growth primarily through legislative involvement, issue advocacy, research, and training and educational activity and may engage in any other lawful purpose.

## Statement of Program Service Accomplishments, Line 4A, Program Services

## a. Public education \$511,370

The organization conducts a program of public education through speeches, articles and TV and radio news interviews to educate citizens on the benefits of pro-growth policies and the work of the organization. Staff members wrote articles on topics including tax policy and excessive spending that appeared in leading newspapers and news outlets, including The Wall Street Journal, USA Today, and National Review Online. Staff members appeared on over 30 nationally distributed TV and radio news programs and dozens of local radio programs.

## b. Publications \$224,064

The organization publishes information in print and on the Internet to educate on economic issues and motivate people to act in support of pro-economic growth policies. Its blog published over 2500 entries, was inducted into the Weblog Awards Hall of Fame and was visited by over 805,000 unique visitors during the fiscal year. It publishes a website on Social Security reforms and publishes a membership newsletter that currently has a circulation of 35,900. Starting in this fiscal year, the organization also began publishing information on Twitter and has published over 975 items using the service. We also maintain listserves with nearly 500 subscribers, primarily well know public policy advocates, on free trade, cap and trade, a proposed rulemaking on regulating greenhouse gas emissions and the "card check" legislation.

## c. Legislative Involvement and Policy Advocacy \$630,816

The organization monitors legislation that can help or harm economic growth, and urges its adoption or rejection by Congress, the President, and state and local governments. In addition to its public education efforts, such actions for legislative involvement and policy advocacy included over 25 letters to Congress and over 50 press releases. It also began preparations for an estimated \$1 million TV ad campaign opposing the health care legislation pending in Congress due to the measure's potential impact on economic growth. To further its efforts to enact proeconomic growth legislation, the organization also periodically publishes reports on congressional roll call votes on legislation that would impact economic growth for distribution to its members and the public.

## d. Lectures and Conferences \$447,543

The organization conducted two conferences during the fiscal year on economic policies that can increase economic growth. The first conference was attended by three current and former governors and ten members of Congress. The second conference featured presentations from seven noted economists, including the chairman of the George Mason University's Economics Department, on policies that would promote economic recovery.

## e. State and Local Legislative Involvement and Policy Activity \$411,378

In order to further its goal of enacting policies that foster economic growth, the organization also makes grants to state or local organizations for legislative involvement work on behalf of such policies. Grants made during the fiscal year were made to local 501(C)(4) groups in support of legislation for tax reform, limited government, school choice and property rights.

## f. Other \$208,402

In order to further its goal to foster economic growth, the organization operated other programs not mentioned above. The programs related to economic growth, such as fiscal responsibility, tax policies, and legal reform.
