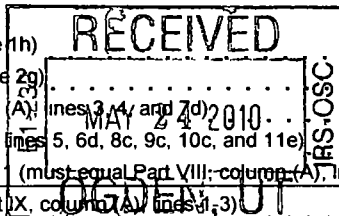

Statement of Program Accomplishments

Mission Statement: Global Goods Partners (GGP) is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to empowering women, alleviating poverty and promoting social justice. GGP partners with community based organizations (CBO) in 24 countries throughout Asia, Africa, the Americas and the Middle East, creating access to the U.S. market for its partners' handcrafted products and providing technical assistance to build sustainable livelihoods for women, their families and their communities.
