(THE "FOUNDATION"), A WHOLLY OWNED SUBSIDIARY OF THE UNITED JEWISH COMMUNITIES OF METROWEST NEW JERSEY, INC., ("UJC"), WAS INCORPORATED IN 1949 AS A NEW JERSEY NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION AND IS EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAXES UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE. THE FOUNDATION'S PRIMARY FUNCTION IS TO RECEIVE, ADMINISTER AND ALLOCATE FUNDS AND PROPERTY FOR UJC AND ITS BENEFICIARY AGENCIES. THE FOUNDATION OPERATES A BEQUEST AND ENDOWMENT PROGRAM WHICH CONDUCTS EDUCATIONAL AND PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF FUNDS FOR CAPITAL PURPOSES AND SPECIAL PROJECTS, AND A PHILANTHROPIC PROGRAM WHICH PROMOTES THE PHILANTHROPIC INTERESTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE UJC THROUGH THE GRANT-MAKING PROCESS. THE FOUNDATION IS COMPRISED OF APPROXIMATELY 725 INDIVIDUAL FUNDS. IN ADDITION, THE FOUNDATION HOLDS AND INVESTS FUNDS FOR THE BENEFIT OF OTHER AFFILIATED AND NON-AFFILIATED ORGANIZATIONS.
