The statement tracks the conflicts of interest policy, requiring each person to disclose information for the reporting period regarding the existence and nature of gifts, outside interests, outside activities and other matters constituting a potential, perceived or actual conflict of interest, and to certify that they have read the policy and answered fully, accurately and to the best of their knowledge. After confirmation that all questions have been answered, the statements are reviewed by the relevant Vice President, Department Chair or other executive (or their designee), tracked by the Office of Compliance and Privacy, and all statements disclosing potential, perceived or actual conflicts are forwarded to the Office of General Counsel for further review and follow-up as needed. The conflicts statements submitted by Trustees of the Hospital and Foundation, and members of Senior Management, are reviewed by the General Counsel and the disclosures are summarized in memoranda distributed to and reviewed by the members of the Audit and Compliance Committee of the Hospital and Foundation Boards. Summary information about compliance with the policy's requirement to submit annual statements and disclosures contained therein is provided in memoranda to the Audit and Compliance Committee of the Boards. In addition, if any matter involving a potential violation of the conflict of interest policy is brought to the attention of management during the course of the year, an investigation is conducted by either the relevant department's management, Office of General Counsel or Office of Compliance and Privacy, as appropriate.
