4a	(Code ) (Expenses \$ 233,260 including grants of \$ 233,260 ) (Revenue \$ 0 )  The Giving Program consists of two funding mechanisms—gifts and grants. Grants are awarded to projects that strenghten ties between individual researchers and industry and seeks to stimulate interest in fluid power on school campuses across the country. The program seeks to provide world-class university research on precompetitive problems of wide interest to the fluid power industry with potential applications within 5 years. Gifts support projects that foster the study of motion control technology from middle through graduate schools with hands-on teaching activities, senior capstone projects, studen competitions, the development of teaching tools, etc.  One grant was awarded to Purdue University for their research in Regenerative Hydraulic Topographies Using High Speed Valves. A provision patent has been filed with research expected to continue through 2011. A total of 10 gifts were awarded to eight universities, one technical college and one educational foundation to develop teaching tools in support of fluid power education, to develop and expand of fluid power curriculum, support student capstone projects using fluid power and fluid power research.
