RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

1. The name of the corporation is BUCKS COUNTY SYMPHONY SOCIETY. The original Articles of Incorporation (the "Original Articles") were filed and recorded in the office of the Secretary of State of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on October 18, 1954, pursuant to the provisions of Article II of the Nonprofit Corporation Law of 1933, as amended.

2. The post office address of the current registered office in this Commonwealth is P.O. Box 500, Doylestown, PA, 18901, Bucks County.

3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(a) To foster and cultivate fine music for the mutual enjoyment and benefit of the residents of Bucks County, Pennsylvania and surrounding areas;

(b) Through active support, encouragement, and assistance, to maintain a symphony orchestra for the cultural benefit of the residents of Bucks County, Pennsylvania and surrounding areas;

(c) To promote musical education programs in which the children of Bucks County, Pennsylvania and surrounding areas can participate; and

(d) To do all things and exercise all rights and powers permitted to nonprofit corporations created under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania including, but without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the right to acquire, hold, use, control and dispose of any kind or kinds of property and to do any and all things incidental thereto, provided, however, that all funds and property of whatsoever kind and nature, personal or real, shall be devoted to the purposes set forth in paragraphs (a) through (c) hereinabove.

4. The corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit incidental or otherwise.

5. The term of its existence is to be perpetual.

6. The corporation is incorporated exclusively for, and the nature of the activities to be conducted and the purposes to be promoted by the corporation exclusively shall be, for charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes within the purview of §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax laws of the United States.

7. The corporation is organized upon a non-stock basis.

8. The corporation shall have no members.

9. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in

Article 3 hereof. Except as may be permitted under the provisions of §501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax laws of the United States, no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The corporation shall neither participate nor intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office, nor shall it take a position on any issue raised in a political campaign for the purpose of aiding or opposing any candidate. Any other provision of these Restated Articles of Incorporation to the contrary notwithstanding, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under §501(a) and §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax laws of the United States; or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under §§170, 2055 and 2522 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax laws of the United States. These Restated Articles of Incorporation shall not be altered or amended in derogation of the provisions of this Article 9.

10. In the event of dissolution or termination of the existence of this corporation, it is irrevocably declared that all of its property and assets shall, after payment or making provisions for payment of the lawful debts of the corporation, and the expenses of its dissolution or termination, be delivered, conveyed and paid over to such one or more qualified organizations as may be ordered by the court having jurisdiction of the dissolution and liquidation of the corporation, pursuant to the appropriate subchapter of the Pennsylvania Nonprofit Corporation Law of 1988, or any successor statute thereto. Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, the corporation shall not be merged or consolidated with any corporation other than a qualified organization. As used in this Article 10, the term "qualified organization" shall mean an organization described in either §501(c)(3) or §170(c)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax laws of the United States (but only if the property delivered, conveyed and paid over to such organization is to be used for exclusively public purposes).


11. These Restated Articles of Incorporation amend and restate in their entirety the Original Articles.
