TURN's MISSION

The mission of the Tenant Union Representative Network is to advance and defend the rights and interests of tenants and homeless people.

Our goal is to guarantee to all Philadelphians equal access to safe, decent, accessible, and affordable housing. We accomplish this goal by developing and implementing a common agenda -involving TURN leadership, staff and membership, and community allies – according to the following principles:

WE ADVOCATE on behalf of tenants and homeless people to guarantee their rights to decent and affordable housing;

WE ORGANIZE our members, tenant groups, communities, community leaders, and others to fight for justice in housing and assure fair treatment and respect for tenants and homeless people;

WE EMPOWER our members, clients, and the community-at-large through educational activities about attacks on tenants' rights and the homeless and the need to organize in our own defense, and how to access help and services;

WE FORM AND JOIN COALTIONS with other individuals and organizations when appropriate and in furtherance of our mission;

WE PROVIDE SERVICES such as financial assistance, social services, and information and referral services, in ways which organize and empower tenants and homeless people to advance their housing rights for themselves and their families, and allow them to access and maintain decent housing.

TURN'S PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

The TURN provides answers to simple landlord/tenant questions over the telephone, individual tenant counseling, self-help workshops and classes, and organizing and rental assistance.

Hotline (215) 940-3900

Hotline counselors answer simple land-lord/tenant questions Monday through Friday from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. This service is limited to those who are locked-out, have had their utilities shut-off or who have received an eviction notice, or have attended a self-help class.

Individualized Counseling

Counselors meet with tenants on an individual basis to discuss housing questions and concerns, and assist in resolving housing-related issues. We counsel tenants who have attended our workshops or who are locked-out, have had their utilities shut-off or who have received and eviction notice.


Self-Help Classes

The TURN conducts free workshops and classes that educate tenants about their legal rights and responsibilities. These workshops are held every day at 10:00 A.M., 12:30 P.M., and 5:00 P.M. at our office.

Tenant Organizing

Experienced tenant organizers meet with tenant groups interested in forming a tenant council at their buildings. We help tenant leaders recruit other members to the tenant union, identify an agenda and action plan for their buildings, negotaiate with management, and build an effective tenant union. Well organized tenant unions have better success with getting repairs, and with successfully dealing with other rental problems.



Fair Housing Action Center

TURN's Fair Housing Action Center (FHAC) investigates alleged discrimination in housing transactions based upon race, color, religion, sex, familial status, mental or physical disability (including HIV/AIDS), age, sexual orientation, ancestry, marital status, and source of income. If you think that you may have been a victim of discrimination, call 1-888-KEPT-OUT.

Emergency Services

The Federal Emergency Mortgage Assistance (FEMA) and Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP) provides low-income Philadelphia residents with rent for one month's back rent, the first month's rent for a new residence, and cash assistance for the highest utility bill in any month.

The Emergency Shelter Assistance (ESA) Program provides emergency housing assistance to low-income Philadelphia residents. Applicants must be referred by their local County Assistance Office, must not exceed 80% of the poverty guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, and must reside in Philadelphia. For additional information, contact the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania at 215-560-1976.
