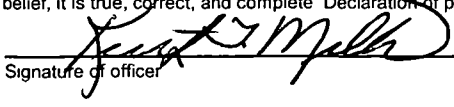
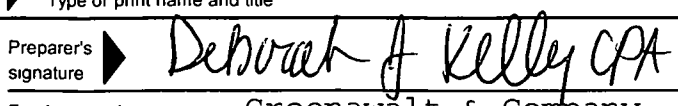

Description

Learn and Serve Grant-funding from the Corporation for National and Community Service Learn & Serve America initiative has created a partnership between Pennsylvania and New York Campus Compacts to promote institutional change by supporting service-learning, community development, and capacity-building within institutions of higher education and among community partners. Subgrants were awarded to eight institutions in PA and NY for academic discipline networks and regional collaborations/consortia. Through the work of these eight subgrants, 3,695 college students were involved in service-learning, 2,228 K-12 students were tutored or mentored by service-learning students, 280 faculty members revised curriculum or taught courses with service-learning and 310 community partners were involved. Best practices of these networks include using technology to communicate with partners, developing resources for faculty with community partner input, engaging students to support and promote service-learning and building upon individual relationships to strengthen networks. The Learn & Serve grant has allowed PACC to develop the resources of regions and support faculty in specific disciplines that are strengthening communities through campus-community partnerships and further promote education for informed civic engagement.

Description

AmericCorps* VISTA (Volunteers in Service to America) provides full-time members to nonprofit, faith-based and other community organizations, and public agencies to create and expand programs that ultimately bring low-income individuals and communities out of poverty. The Pennsylvania Campus Compact (PACC) VISTA program is based on college/university campuses and dedicated to the elimination of poverty by developing campus-community partnerships, mobilizing volunteers to serve their communities, and raising funds to sustain long-term programming. PACC*VISTA members work in a variety of areas, including tutoring and mentoring, health access for insured residents, affordable housing construction, income tax assistance for low-income families, among others. In 2008, PACC*VISTA members mobilized 4,797 student and community volunteers, who in turn provided 40,767 hours of voluntary service to those in need. Additionally, PACC*VISTA members raised over \$ 67,900 to support community programs and secured over \$ 16,670 worth of in-kind donations.

Description

Martin Luther King Day-In January 2009, seven PACC member campuses organized community service events to celebrate the life of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. through mini-grants of \$ 250 provided by Pennsylvania Campus Compact. The MLK Day 2009 mini-grantees were; Bucknell University, Elizabethtown College, Gwynedd-Mercy College, Kutztown University, Lock Haven University, Millersville University, and Saint Vincent College. As a result of the support provided by the mini-grants, these seven campuses recruited over 1,000 student and community volunteers to partner with 69 community organizations for projects that ranged from winterizing homes to working with youth to painting public trash cans in revitalization efforts.

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
