



AMENDMENT TO BYLAWS

SECTION 6.03. SELECTION AND TERM OF OFFICE. The directors of the Corporation shall be elected in accordance with the provisions of this Section 6.03. at the annual, regular or special meetings of the Board as either Representative Directors (defined below). Community Directors (defined below). At-Large Directors (defined below), or Emeritus Director (defined below) and the status of each director shall be noted in the minutes of the meeting at which he or she is so elected. Each director of the Corporation must be a member in good standing of either a Sustaining Club (defined below) or an Affiliated Club (defined below), or otherwise be designated by the Board as a Community Director (defined below), or an At-Large Director (defined below). Employees of Sustaining Clubs and Affiliated Clubs shall not be eligible to serve as directors of the Corporation. There shall be no limit on the number of consecutive terms a director may serve. Notwithstanding the expiration of their terms, directors shall remain in office until their successors have been elected and qualified. The directors of the Corporation shall be selected, and their terms shall be as follows:

- (a) **REPRESENTATIVE DIRECTORS.** Representative Directors of the Corporation will be elected to the Board in accordance with the following provisions:
 - (i) **FROM SUSTAINING CLUBS.** The following country clubs, which for many years hosted and sponsored the Corporation's charity golf tournament now known as the Bob Hope Chrysler Classic (the "Classic") are designated by the Corporation as "Sustaining Clubs". BERMUDA DUNES COUNTRY CLUB, LA QUINTA COUNTRY CLUB and TAMARISK COUNTRY CLUB. The Board may, in its discretion, remove a country club from the Sustaining Club category at any time.

Each Sustaining Club shall have the right to be represented on the Board by two (2) directors, who shall be nominated from the Sustaining Club's membership. Subject to the approval of the Board, each two (2) such directors, and the Board shall have the option, exercisable in its discretion, to nominate one (1) such director. In the event the Board does not exercise its option to nominate one (1) director from a Sustaining Club's membership, the Sustaining Club shall have the right, subject to the approval of the Board to nominate such director. The term of office of Representative Directors of Sustaining Clubs shall be two (2) years and such terms shall be staggered.

- (ii) **FROM AFFILIATED CLUBS.** From time to time, the Board may, but shall not be required to, designate as an "Affiliated Club" any country club that hosts and sponsors, or has in the past hosted or sponsored, the Classic, and may set a number of director, from zero (0) to one (1), who shall be

elected to the Board from the Affiliated Club's membership. ELDORADO COUNTRY CLUB, INDIAN WELLS COUNTRY CLUB and PGA WEST are hereby designated by the Corporation as an Affiliated Club. The Board may, in its discretion, remove a country club from the Affiliated Club category at any time.

If an Affiliated Club is entitled to be represented by a director pursuant to this Section 6.03 (a) (ii), such director shall be nominated from the Affiliated Club's membership. The Board shall have the option, exercisable in its discretion, to nominate such director. In the event the Board does not exercise its option to nominate such director, the Affiliated Club shall have the right, subject to the approval of the Board, to nominate such director. The term of office of Representative Directors of Affiliated Clubs shall be one year.

(b) **COMMUNITY DIRECTORS.** From time to time, the Board may, but shall not be required to, nominate up to four (4) individuals in any one year to serve as a Community Director. A Community Director is not required to be a member of either a Sustaining Club or an Affiliated Club. The term of Community Director shall be one year.

(c) **AT-LARGE DIRECTORS.** The Board shall nominate as "At-Large Directors" that number of directors as may be required so that the total number of directors of the Corporation equals the number fixed pursuant to Section 6.02; *provided, however*, that if any person who has served two (2) terms as President and Tournament Chairman of the Classic is not nominated as a Representative Director by his Sustaining Club or Affiliated Club, he shall automatically be appointed to the Board as an At-Large Director. An At-Large Director is not required to be a member of either a Sustaining Club or an Affiliated Club. The term of office of At-Large Directors shall be one year.

(d) **EX OFFICIO DIRECTORS.** In the interest of continuity and for the good of the Classic, if the immediate past President and Tournament Chairman of the Classic is not elected as a director of the Corporation, he shall automatically be appointed as an ex officio director, without voting rights and not to count for purposes of Section 6.11, for a period of one (1) year from the end of his service as President and Tournament Chairman.

(e) **EMERITUS DIRECTOR.** From time to time, the Board may, but is not required to, nominate up to four (4) individuals in any one (1) year to serve as a Emeritus Director. An Emeritus Director will not constitute a quorum under Section 6.11; and holds no voting right. Upon the request of the Board an Emeritus Director can participate in Board meetings. An Emeritus Director may receive Board member benefits at the directions of the Board. It is the intent of the Board to offer the title of Emeritus Director as a means to honor the selective individuals. The Emeritus Director will not be eligible to serve as an Officer of the Corporation. The term of office of Emeritus Director will be limited to (1) year terms.
