The Center provides comprehensive mental health services to the residents of Cass, Fulton, Miami, and Pulaski Counties on both an inpatient and outpatient basis. Care is provided to patients who meet certain criteria under its charity care policy at amounts less than its established rates. Because the Center does not pursue collection of amounts determined to qualify as charity care, these amounts are not reported as net service revenue. The amount of charges foregone for services and supplies furnished under the Center's charity care policy is \$3,501,513 in 2009. The amount includes reductions in fees based on the client's ability to pay and client services performed free of charge. The policy is in place to assist Four County Counseling Center directors, officers, associates, and agents who govern and administer Four County Counseling Center affairs to resolve situations that involve a dual interest or that may be interpreted as a conflict of interest and to define conflict of interest situations and procedures to follow once they are disclosed. The covered persons are held to a strict rule of honest and fair dealing between themselves and the Corporation. They shall not use their positions, or knowledge gained therefrom, in such a way that a conflict might arise between the interest in the Corporation and that of the individual. A self disclosure from covered persons to other board members is required on any potential conflicts of interest. Any director having a duality of interest or possible conflict of interest on any matter should not vote or use his or her personal influence on the matter, and he or she should not be counted in determining the quorum for the meeting, even where permitted by law. The minutes of the meeting should reflect a disclosure was made, the abstention from voting, and that a quorum was present.
