Self-reliance programs help at-risk people live on their own by helping them gain the skills they need to get through life. Programs include counseling, employment services, life skills, food pantries, emergency assistance and transitional housing. Create financial stability through education and employment services such as job preparedness and training. Provide supportive housing that is affordable and helps mitigate factors that lead to homelessness such as low income, substance abuse, health issues, and aging.

PACES is a collaborative program between Peoria Public Schools and Heart of Illinois United Way member agencies that administers substance abuse, violence prevention and mental health programs for students in kindergarten through high school. The program focuses on mental health screening and counseling, substance abuse prevention and abeyance case management.

The Heart of Illinois United Way has 45 partner agencies who receive funding for 112 programs through a competitive grant process. The partner agencies elect the Board of Directors each year at the annual meeting.

Each position has a salary range that is updated based on current pay studies and employee pay rates are based on these ranges.
