BYLAWS OF FIFTH STREET RENAISSANCE/SALA CENTER

ARTICLE I - OFFICES

The principle offices of the corporation shall be located at 1315 North Fifth Street, Springfield, Illinois. The corporation may have other offices within or without the state. The Board retains the right to relocate the registered office as it deems appropriate and the registered agent shall be at that office. This corporation is organized exclusively for the charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) T of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or any provisions corresponding to same of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductive under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or any provisions corresponding to same of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE II - MISSION

The mission of Fifth Street Renaissance is to assist individuals and families in difficult situations who are making the transition to be productive members of society by providing transitional housing and opportunities to develop job skills and acquire education, employment, and housing. It is also our goal to assist those individuals diagnosed with HIV-AIDS, their caregivers and families by helping to locate and find housing, medical assistance, counseling and when necessary, fiscal responsibility. The agency will also work to halt the spread of HIV-AIDS by education awareness and prevention.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERS

- **Section1. Membership:** There shall be a single class of members. Any person making annual contribution of time, in-kind or money to the corporation is a member.
- **Section2. Voting Rights:** Each regular member shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote of the members.

ARTICLE IV - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- **Section1. General Powers:** The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors.
- **Section2. Voting:** Each director shall be entitled to one (1) vote on any matter submitted to the Board. Directors shall not be permitted to vote by proxy.

- Section3. Number, Tenure and Qualifications: The number condirectors shall be minimum of twelve (12) and a maximum of seventeen (20). Directors shall be elected to serve for a two (2) year term. All Directors are to be elected by a majority of members present if a quorum is seated. Directors shall be nominated for election by the nominating committee. Directors shall serve until the expiration of their terms.
- Section4. Board of Directors shall hold at least six (6) monthly meetings per year, in addition to the annual meeting. These meetings shall be held at the registered office or at such place specified by the Board.
- Annual Meeting: An Annual meeting of the membership shall be held in the month of May or any other date at such date, time, and place as the Board of Directors shall set. One purpose of the annual meeting shall be the election of officers. (See Article VI Officers: Section 2. Term of Office)
- **Other Regular Meetings:** The Board of Directors may provide by resolution the time and place for the holding of additional regular meetings of the Board without other notice than such resolution.
- Section 7. Special Meetings: Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by or at the request of the president or any three (3) directors. The person(s) authorized to call special meetings of the Board may fix any place as the place for holding special meeting of the Board called by them.
- Notice: Notice of any special meeting of the Board of Directors shall be give at least seven (7) days prior thereto by written notice to each director at the address shown for such director on the records of the corporation. If mailed or electronically generated, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when properly deposited in the United States mail or verified at the recipient's location. Neither the business to be transacted at, nor the purpose of a special meeting of the Board need be specified in the notice of such meeting, unless specifically required by law or by these bylaws.

- Section 9. Quorum: At all meetings of the Board of Directors, plus one of active members of the sitting Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, provided that if less than a quorum of the directors is present at said meeting, a majority of the directors present may adjourn the meeting to another time without further notice.
- Manner of Acting: The act of majority of the directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Directors, unless the act of a greater number is required by statute, the articles of incorporation or these bylaws.
- Section11. Action Without Meeting: The Board of Directors may empower director(s) to act on specific matters requiring consideration of the Board. Director(s) shall only act on matters that have been assigned for action by a majority vote of the Board.
- **Section12.** Vacancies: Any vacancy occurring in the Board of Directors or any directorship to be filled by reason of an increase in the number of directors shall be filled by the Board of Directors. A director elected to fulfill a vacancy shall serve a two (2) year term.
- Section13. Statements: No Board member or committee member shall assume to represent or speak on behalf of Fifth Street Renaissance unless and until it has been approved by the Board.
- Section14. Compensation: The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall serve without compensation. This provision shall not preclude a Director from serving the Corporation in any other capacity and receiving reasonable compensation for nor shall this provision preclude the Board from by policy or by individual action from providing for reimbursement to the Directors or Officers for reasonable expenses legitimately incurred in the performance of their duties.
- Section15. Resignation and Removal of Directors: A Director may resign at any time upon written notice to the Board of Directors. A Director may be removed with or without cause as specified by statute. If a Director should fail to attend three (3) consecutive meetings, without prior notice, he or she shall be deemed to have resigned at the end of such period, unless the Board of Directors excuses such absence. Such a resignation shall be considered a vacancy as to which the provisions in Section 12 above, shall apply.

ATRICLE V - COMMITTEES

Section1. Committees: The Board of Directors may designate one (1) or more committees, which will be chaired by a director. The membership of committee(s) shall be reported to the Board. Each committee shall consist of two (2) or more individuals.

Manner of Acting: The actions of each committee, small be approved by the Board of Directors before having the effect of binding and/or becoming the policy of Fifth Street Renaissance Transitional Homeless Shelter unless otherwise provided in the resolution creating such committee and except as limited by law, the articles of incorporation or these bylaws. Any Committee(s) established under Article V, Section 1 of these bylaws shall determine its meeting time and manner of conducting its business. The actions of the majority of the committee members present at the called meeting shall be the actions of the committee.

Section3. <u>Term of Office</u>: Committees shall serve at the will of the Board.

Section4. Quorum: Unless otherwise provided in the resolution of the Board of Directors designating a committee, a majority of the whole committee shall constitute a quorum, a quorum shall be present for the committee to conduct business.

ARTICLE VI – OFFICERS

Section 1. Requirements: No two (2) officers shall be related by blood, marriage, emotional attachment or share the same habitat. All officers shall be forthcoming concerning this information.

Section2. Enumeration: The officers of the corporation shall be president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer. The Board of Directors may also elect one or more additional or other officers or assistant or co-officers as it shall deem appropriate. Officers whose authority and duties are not prescribed in these bylaws shall have the authority and perform the duties prescribed, from time to time, by the Board of Directors.

Term of Office: The officers of the corporation shall be elected for one (1) year terms, prior to the beginning of each fiscal year and shall hold office until their successors are elected and qualified or until their death, resignation or removal. Vacancies may be filled at any meeting of the Board of Directors. Election of an officer shall not of itself create contract rights. Any officer elected by the Board of Directors may be removed by the Board, whenever in its judgment, the best interests of the corporation would be served thereby. Such removal shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the person so removed.

Section4. President: ...e president shall be principal executive officer of the corporation and shall perform all duties incident to the office of President and such other duties as may be assigned to him/her by the Board of Directors.

Vice-President: The Vice-President shall perform such duties and have such other powers as shall be assigned to him/her by the President and/or the Board of Directors. Further, in the absence of the President or in the event of his/her inability or refusal to act, the Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President

Secretary: The Secretary shall: keep a record of all proceedings of the Board of Directors in a book to be kept for that purpose; see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these bylaws or as required by law; be custodian of the corporate records and of the seal of the corporation; and perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him/her by the President or by the Board of Directors.

Treasurer: The Treasurer shall have charge of and be responsible for the maintenance of adequate books of account for the corporation; have charge and custody of all funds and securities of the corporation, and be responsible for the receipt and disbursement thereof; and perform all duties incident to the office of a treasurer and such other duties as may be assigned to him/her by the President or the Board of Directors. At the direction of the Board, the Treasurer's duties may be assigned to other persons under the supervision of the Treasurer. The Board of Directors shall require an annual audit for the corporation be prepared by an independent certified public accountant.

Section8. Assistant Treasurer: The Assistant Treasurer shall perform monthly audits of Social Security Payee clients for compliance to Social Security and Fifth Street Renaissance policies; review all contracts and grants to determine reporting requirements and time tables for addition to the master calendar.

Section9. Past President:-The Past President will provide historical background for previous Board decisions when necessary; act as advisor and historian for the Board of Directors and Executive Board.

ARTICLE VII- GENERAL PR. ISIONS

Section1. Contracts: The Board of Directors may authorize any officer(s) or agent(s) of the
corporation to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in
the name of and on behalf of the corporation and such authority may be general
or confined to specific instance.

Checks, drafts, etc: All funds of the corporation shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the corporation in such banks, trust companies, or other depositories as the Board of Directors may select. All checks, drafts or other orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the corporation, shall be signed by such officer(s) or agent(s) of the corporation and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the Board of Directors. No deposit shall be made by those individuals with access to the financial records.

Section3. Fiscal Year: The fiscal year of the corporation shall be fixed by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Waiver of Notice: Whenever any notice is required to be given under law, the articles of the incorporation or the bylaws of the corporation, a waiver thereof in writing signed by the person or persons entitled to such notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice.

Amendments: The power to alter, amend or repeal the bylaws or adopt new bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors. Such action may be taken at a regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors for which prior written notice of the purpose shall be given. The bylaws may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the corporation not inconsistent with law or the articles of the incorporation. The proposed by-laws or changes shall be made available to all Board members by receipt/received e-mail, or by hand delivering or by US Mail. Notice of the meeting at which the Board votes on such changes shall be mailed to all members after proposed by-laws have been approved fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting where the amendments/ change shall be voted upon. Amendments/Changes in the bylaws shall require a quorum of the Board of Directors present for action and must be adopted by a 2/3 majority.

ARTICLE VIII- INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE

Indemnification: The corporation may, at the discretion of the Board of Directors indemnify any director, officer, or employee against any cost, claim or liability such individual had incurred or may incur in connection with the service of the corporation as permitted by the Illinois Compiled Statutes, 805 ILCS 105/108.75.

Director's _bility Insurance: The corporation may __irchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation, or who is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a venture, trust or other enterprise, against any liability asserted against such person and incurred by such person in any such capacity, or arising out of his/her status as such, whether or not the corporation would have the power to indemnify such person against such liability under the provisions of this Article VIII.

Section3. Reporting Indemnification: If the corporation had paid indemnity or has advanced expenses under this Article VIII for a director, officer, employee or agent, the corporation shall report the indemnification or advance in writing to the directors immediately after issuing payment.

ARTICLE IX - DISSOLUTION OF THE CORPORATION

١,

In the event of dissolution of the Organization for any cause whatever, all of its assets and property over and above what is required for the payment of its just debts and obligations shall be distributed to its successor organization and shall then as now be exempt from federal taxation. Should such successor fail to qualify, then all property of the Organization shall be donated to another not-for-profit in the Organization's area as designated by the Board of Directors.
