In some program instances, in East. A frica, for example, we receive copies of travel documents and bills for airfare to substantiate the transactions before transmitting funds. We also receive reports on the training program, and the site is visited by the program director to review program results and at times to participate in the training events. In the case of cross-cultural internships which are a part of the Mentored Ministries Program, need is determined by application process, supervisors are interviewed, provided with training and advice, then subsequent to the internship, reports are provided from the supervisors and on the performance of the student interns, and the students also report on the experience and the use of the funds upon return. The Facing Your Future Program sends chaperons to accompany the participants, who observe the use of funds, then the organization provides a summary of the expenses which are reviewed by the program director.
