McGuire shall continue to hold office until their successors are elected or until their earlier resignation, removal or death, along with Richard D. Merillat or Lynette S. Merillat and John Thurman. If at any time while serving as Trustee, Wendy R. Lyon, Collette C. Cook or Tricia L.M. McGuire becomes unable or unwilling to serve as Trustee, she shall not be replaced, provided that the number of Trustees of the Corporation shall always not be less than three (3).
