This includes educational program development and delivery of Instructional Television, Online and Multimedia Resources to students and teachers in Wisconsin. The ECB also develops educational resources such as interactive Web sites, datacasting, computer software, DVD's and CD-ROMs. During 2009 there were 525,000 public television viewers per week and 28,258 public television contributors. Also in 2008 there were 628,363 instructional media student viewers and 39,750 instructional media classroom teachers. Wisconsin Public Television is delivered via 5 tv transmitters and 5 tv translators located throughout the state.
