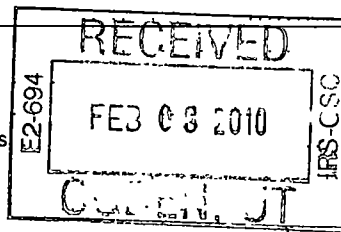

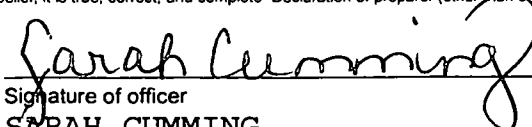

GAMMA CHAPTER ALUMNI
By-Laws

I. NAME AND IDEALS

Section 1: The name of this organization shall be Gamma Chapter Alumni of Lambda Delta Phi.

Section 2: The aims of the Gamma Chapter Alumni shall be:

- A. To provide an opportunity for women of all races, religious, and cultural backgrounds to live, work, and maintain social relations on an equal level.
- B. To encourage a high degree of moral and personal integrity.
- C. To encourage unity without the loss of individuality.
- D. To strive for cultural and intellectual growth.
- E. To promote these our ideals beyond the confines of our individual groups.

II. MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: Member Qualifications and Requirements

- A. Any woman, regardless of race, religion, culture, or sexual orientation who has been granted alumnae status by the active Gamma Chapter.
- B. This shall be open to a sister who has paid annual alumni dues of \$30 per alumni's fiscal year. (July-June)

III. ELECTION AND DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 1: Procedure for election

- A. Elections shall be held at Founder's Day Annual Meeting unless a special election is needed at the Spring Luncheon Annual Meeting.
- B. Nominations will be made at the meeting and another member present may speak on behalf of a nominee that cannot be present.
- C. All officers shall hold office for a term of three years, January to December.
- D. In case of vacancy of an officer, an election will be held at the closest annual meeting date.
- E. Officers may be elected by voice vote or secret ballot, whichever is most appropriate at the time.
- F. A candidate for office shall be considered elected when she has reviewed a plurality of the votes cast by at least 2/3 of all the active membership present.
- G. All active members attending the election meeting will be allowed to vote.

Section 2: The following officers shall be elected at the election meeting and shall perform these prescribed duties:

A. President

- 1. Attends all Alumni Board meetings.
- 2. Signs all official documents.
- 3. Presides over all meetings of Gamma Chapter Alumni.
- 4. Has the power to call any special meetings deemed necessary.
- 5. Works with the active president to see how the alumni can assist the chapter.
- 6. Oversee all Alumni Board officers.
- 7. Organizes 1 active/alumni board event per year.
- 8. To effectively manage and grow Lambda Delta Phi as a professional organization by promoting our Aims and Ideals, chapter goals and constitution.
- 9. Work with the active and alumni boards to determine current goals.

B. Vice President

- 1. Attends all Alumni Board meetings.
- 2. Perform duties of the President in her absence. If the president is unable to continue her responsibilities, she will assume them until a new president is elected.

3. Assumes duties of parliamentarian and shall be responsible for advising the presiding officer regarding all matters of parliamentary procedure.
4. Keep a current record of constitutional by-laws and policies for the Gamma Chapter Alumni and active Gamma Chapter.
5. Shall be responsible for reviewing the existing constitution and by-laws of Gamma Chapter and Gamma Chapter Alumni and recommend necessary revisions to actives, alumni or national.
6. Distribute updated copies of constitution and by-laws to Alumni Board officers.
7. Work with the active Gamma Chapter First Vice President.

C. Secretary

1. Attends all Alumni Board meetings.
2. Records all proceedings of the organization in the minutes and distributes to Alumni Board in a timely manner.
3. Is responsible for keeping a file of the minutes of Gamma Chapter Alumni.
4. Maintains Alumni Board contact sheet.

D. Treasurer

1. Attends all Alumni Board meetings.
2. Sends bills and collects dues.
3. Receives and keeps an accurate account of checking and savings accounts.
4. Ensure all outstanding bills are paid on time and to keep the Alumni Board aware of account status.
5. Monitor, make recommendations and report status of financial investments.
6. Work with Gamma Chapter active treasurer and FPA to maintain proper funds in accounts and Gamma Chapter account.
7. Updates and maintains 3 co-signers for Gamma Chapter Alumni checking account with bank.
8. Will seek and have bond insurance during their term as treasurer.

E. Property Manager

1. Attends all Alumni Board meetings.
2. Be the point of contact for any interior/exterior problems with the chapter house.
3. Manage all appliances, furniture, interior/exterior paint, electrical, yard, sign and any other components of the chapter house.
4. When problems arise, determine the best solution based on price, capacity and usage. Consulting the board and informing them of any changes.
5. Make frequent visits to the house to ensure requirements are being followed by those living in the chapter house.
6. Coordinate fire inspections twice a year.
7. Work with vendors to ensure the house meets city codes, that all appliances are in order and that the house property is in good condition.
8. Work with the Gamma Chapter house managers when needed.
9. Work with Gamma Chapter house managers to maintain live in occupancy and housing contracts.

F. Alumni Relations

1. Attends all Alumni Board meetings.
2. Coordinate and manage biannual newsletter with information from alumni, alumni board, active board and active chapter. Layout, print and mail newsletter.
3. Manage alumni address lists and email lists.
4. Communicate with the alumni and the alumni board using the listserv, sending out announcements as needed. Such as save the date and officer position announcements.
5. Notify alumni of a sister's passing and send necessary correspondence and gifts.

Section 3: The following officer shall be agreed upon by the Gamma Chapter and Gamma Chapter Alumni Board

A. Active Advisor

1. Attends all Alumni Board meetings.
2. Liaison between the Gamma Chapter and the Gamma Chapter Alumni updating both groups on pertinent issues allowing everyone to be of the same understanding.
3. Attend active chapter meetings as necessary and as requested by the Gamma Chapter.
4. Contribute to discussion when needed and if the Aims and Ideals are not withheld.
5. Resource for the Gamma Chapter.
6. Been an active Gamma Chapter alumni member for at least three years prior.
7. Will be given a mid-semester review by the active Gamma Chapter. Feedback will then be shared with the President of the Alumni Gamma Chapter.

Section 4: The following officer may be appointed by the Alumni Board.

A. Advisor

1. Attend Alumni Board meetings when necessary.
2. Resource for the Gamma Chapter Alumni commonly a past Alumni Board officer.

Section 5: The Alumni Board

- A. The Alumni Board shall consist of all elected officers and appointed officers.
- B. The Alumni Board of Gamma Chapter Alumni shall perform the following duties:
 1. Periodically check the discharging of the duties of officers.
 2. Call any special meetings.
 3. Guide and assist the Gamma Chapter in upholding the Aims and Ideals and in any other needed capacity.

IV. MEETING

Section 1: Unless otherwise ordered by the Alumni Board of Gamma Chapter Alumni, regular meetings will be held in Spring (Spring Luncheon) and Fall (Founder's Day).

Section 2: The President of the Alumni Board shall have the power to call any special meeting deemed necessary.

Section 3: The Alumni Board will have meetings once per quarter and as needed to maintain operations and assist the Gamma Chapter.

Section 4: If necessary email meetings maybe be used to address an urgent issue or concern that involves the Active Gamma Chapter or Alumni Gamma Chapter.

V. WEARING OF PINS

Section 1: The official sorority pin must be worn over the heart and must be worn only on dress clothes.

Section 2: Letters may not be worn by anyone other than active members, with the exception of parents. Any letters worn by parents must be specifically designated. Example: "Lambda Delta Phi Mom"

- A. Sorority name and/or letters cannot be worn while consuming alcohol or when participating in any illegal activity

VI. AMENDMENTS

Section 1: Amendments may be proposed by the Alumni Board or an alumni member.

Section 2: Adoption of the amendments must be approved by 2/3 of the paid membership present at Spring Luncheon (March/April).

Section 3: Any amendment proposed at a Spring Luncheon may be voted on during that session.

Section 4: Any amendment proposed after Spring Luncheon may be submitted to the Alumni Board President for consideration at the next Spring Luncheon.
