PRINCIPIA'S PRIMARY PURPOSE IS TO SERVE THE CAUSE OF CHRISTIAN SCIENCE AS AN INDEPENDENT EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION, PROVIDING PRE-KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 12TH GRADE EDUCATION ON ITS CAMPUS IN WEST ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AND COLLEGE EDUCATION FORTY MILES NORTH OF ST. LOUIS ON BLUFFS OVERLOOKING THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER IN ELSAH, ILLINOIS. PRINCIPIA, ESTABLISHED IN 1898, ACCEPTS NO GOVERNMENT FUNDING AND IS NOT AN ACTIVITY OF THE CHRISTIAN SCIENCE CHURCH. IN THE FALL OF 1897 MARY KIMBALL MORGAN, A CHRISTIAN SCIENTIST, BEGAN HOMESCHOOLING HER TWO SONS BECAUSE SHE BELIEVED SHE COULD GIVE THEM A FULLER EDUCATION THAN WHAT WAS BEING OFFERED IN THE ST. LOUIS PUBLIC SCHOOLS. THE BASIS FOR MRS. MORGAN'S EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY CAME FROM THE WRITINGS OF MARY BAKER EDDY, THE DISCOVERER AND FOUNDER OF CHRISTIAN SCIENCE. AS OTHER CHRISTIAN SCIENCE PARENTS DISCOVERED THE EDUCATION THE MORGAN BOYS WERE RECEIVING AT HOME, MANY ASKED TO ENROLL THEIR CHILDREN. THE NAME PRINCIPIA, MEANING "FIRST PRINCIPLES,
